In all its activities the Union seeks to co-operate with all other Catholic Societies and looks forward hopefully to the day when all such Societies may be united and work together under one leadership for the support of Catholic Principles and Practice.

**Conditions of Membership.** Membership is open to all members of the Church of England and of Churches in Communion with her who are communicants, and the minimum subscriptions are as follows:—Full Members 10/- a year; Associates 2/6; and Adherents 1/-.
